On October 17, 2022, the Structural Engineering Institute Graduate Student Chapter conducted a special ASCE-SEI Webinar on the topic "Bridge Demolition with Explosives". The webinar was selected from the catalog of ondemand webinars in ASCE's official website. It was an hour-long webinar which talked about safe and controlled demolition of existing bridge structures using explosives. The presentation covered typical scenarios where explosive demolition was a viable alternative to surgical removal of bridge components and discussed the engineering and community outreach preparation which is very important for an explosive bridge demolition project. The webinar also presented a handful of highly insightful case studies. A total of 42 undergraduate and graduate students attended the webinar.
