Md Ala Uddin, Secretary

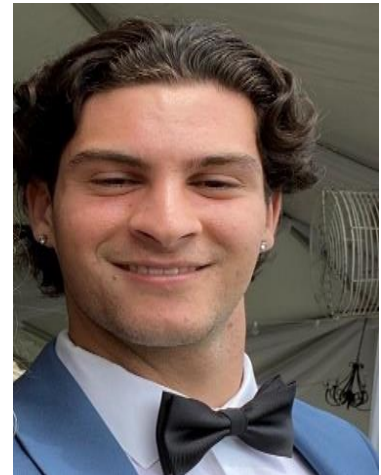
